Christmas is a Journey!

In our culture, we focus on **Christmas <u>DAY</u>** as our major winter holiday. Of course, that's December 25, Jesus' birthday! However, there are a couple of problems with that. First, no one knows on what day of which month he was born; even the exact year is in question. Second, the date that has been settled on in the Western Church (Roman Catholic and Protestant) is different from that identified by the Eastern Orthodox Christian world. The dates of Christmas in different societies vary between December 25 and January 6, 7 or even 19.

Actually, the impact of the Christmas message can't be contained in one day. That's why we often hear the phrase **Christmas** <u>SEASON</u>. This concept didn't emerge for commercial reasons, with retailers reminding us how many "Shopping Days 'Til Christmas." The commemoration of Advent, practiced in most Christian denominations begins forty days before the actual holiday. The Twelve Days of Christmas is another tradition that spreads the holiday experience beyond the one day.
